Bedding Configuration

- 1 Queen and 1 single bed cabin to port, 1 Queen bed cabin, 1 Other Double bed cabin starboard aft, Saloon table can convert to a bed
- 2 Heads (both electric toilets) – 1 with separate shower
- Hot and Cold Deck Shower

Kitchen and Entertainment

- insulated food storage fridge
- 3 burner gas stove with oven, microwave, BBQ upstairs
- DVD player/ flat screen TV with digital tuner
- Sound system with tuner, CD, USB and MP3

Charter Inclusions

- Fuel
- LPG gas
- 8 person inflatable rib tender with outboard

Bedding

- Summer weight blankets, plus doonas and pillows are on board.
- Fresh sheets, pillow cases, towels

Kitchen

- All cutlery, crockery, cups, glasses (plastic for safety) and cooking implements, pots, pans etc. are on board.
- Tea, coffee, sugar - toilet paper, cleaning items, rubbish bags etc are provided

What to Bring

- Bring your own provisions, drinks and ice – and don't forget plenty of bottled water. The water tanks are clean but we recommend that for drinking - bottled water is a safer option.
- Remember NO rigid plastic or metal food containers, eskies or coolers – they can damage the yacht.
- Bring light summer clothing - but bring a fleece or similar and wet weather jacket in case the weather turns cool or wet.
- Wear light soled non slip shoes (you'll kick something in bare feet) - bring hats and sailing gloves.
- Remember pack in soft bags which are easier to store on board.
- **Phone chargers etc**
